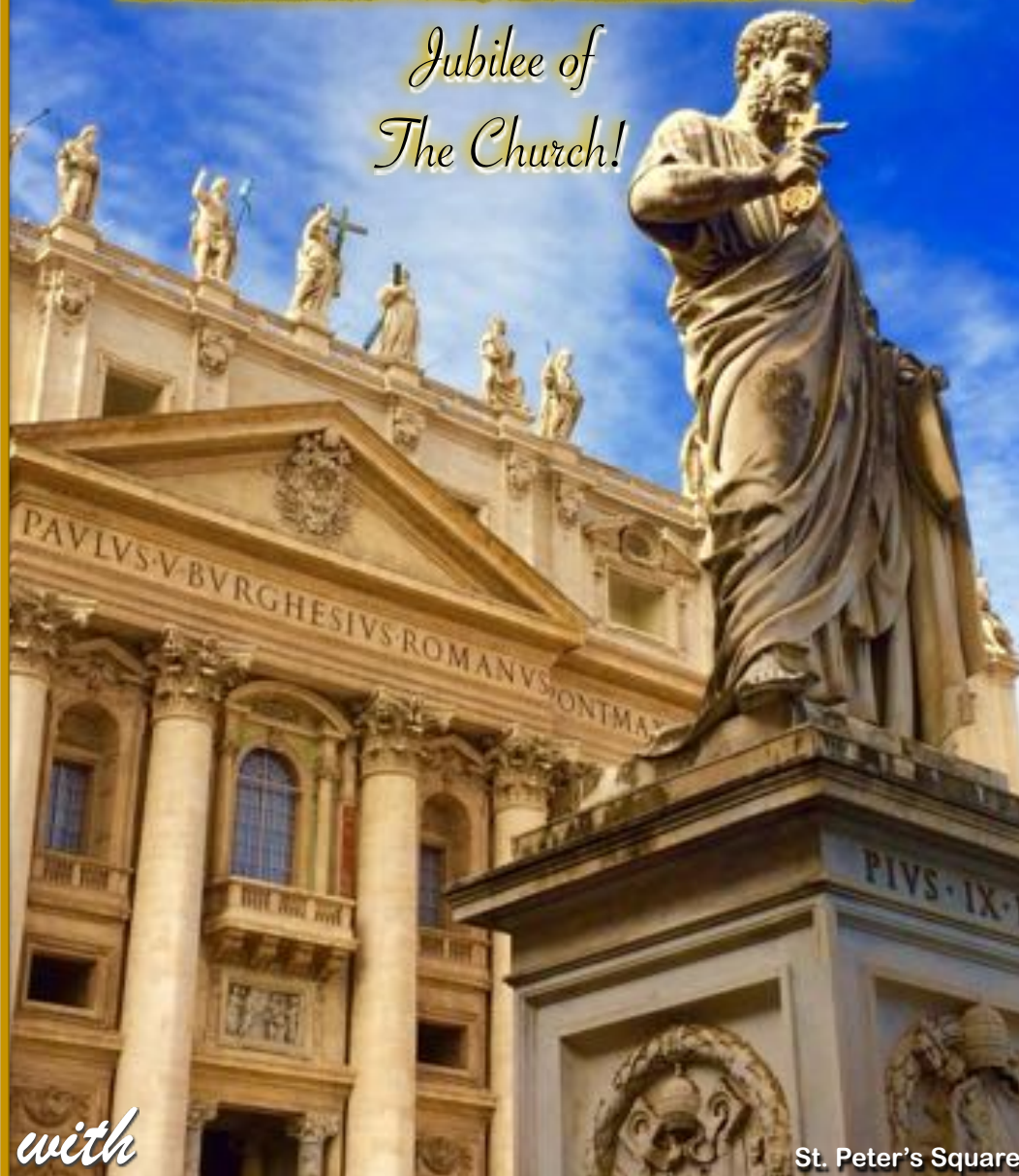

Day 1: Monday, August 11th, 2025: USA departure. (M) Depart the USA for Rome, Italy, and enjoy dinner, drinks and video entertainment onboard as you fly to the European continent. Airfare included from **Chicago O'Hare**. (Airfare may be available from other cities for an additional price).

Day 2: Tuesday, August 12th: Welcome to Italy. Rome, Orvieto & Siena. (M, D) Arrive in Rome and after clearing Italian Immigrations and Customs, board your coach and travel to the hill-top town of **Orvieto**. Very famous for its white wine and fine pottery, but more importantly, Orvieto is the location for the Cathedral that houses the **Eucharistic Miracle of Bolsena**. Marvel at the preserved Corporal still exhibiting the **Blood Stains** of the Eucharistic Miracle, which inspired St. Thomas Aquinas to compose the "**Pange Lingua**" and the "**Adoro Te Devote**", two of the five hymns composed by the Saint for the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, instituted by Pope Urban IV in 1264. Learn about this miracle and enjoy the fascinating façade of the Cathedral as well as the beautiful art inside. **Mass** to be celebrated in Orvieto. Afterward continue to the fertile and picturesque Tuscan countryside and arrive in **Siena**, the land of **St. Catherine & St. Bernardino**. Join your group for dinner followed by a most deserved rest (1st of 2 nights in Siena).



Day 3: Wednesday, August 13th: Siena. (B, WTD) After breakfast, visit the superbly preserved medieval town of **Siena**, known for its famous Saints as well as the legendary '**Palio**', a grand festival celebrated twice a year with a 'no rules' horse race. Our walking tour takes us through the mini-neighborhoods of Siena and includes the beautifully detailed facade of the **Cathedral of Siena**, a visit inside the **Church of St. Dominic** (where the relic of the head of **St. Catherine** can be found), magnificent **Palio Square** and other important places. After the tour we will proceed to the **Basilica di San Francesco** (part of the Franciscan Friary in Siena), where **Holy Mass*** is celebrated.

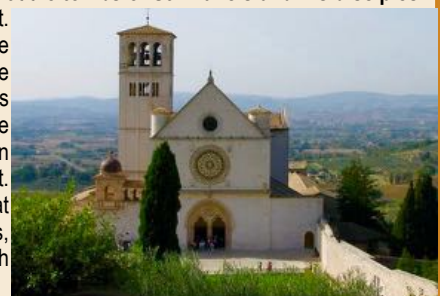


Afterwards, witness the ongoing **Eucharistic Miracle of Siena!** This evening, we have the rare and unforgettable opportunity of tasting wine with a light dinner in Tuscany. Afterwards, return to your hotel.

Day 4: Thursday, August 14th: Assisi. (B, D) This morning, after breakfast, depart Siena and embark on a journey across Tuscany and Umbria, the heart of Italy, to the beautiful city of **Assisi**. Upon arrival in lower Assisi, pray at the '**Porziuncula**' (the first Franciscan house), the **Transitus Chapel** (where St. Francis died), and the **thorn-less rose garden**, all inside the stunning **St. Mary of the Angels Basilica**, the head-mother church of the Franciscan Order. After this visit, continue to upper Assisi. Enter its medieval walls to check in at our hotel for a 2-night stay. Enjoy **dinner** in Assisi with your fellow pilgrims. Leisure time after dinner.



Day 5: Friday, August 15th: Assisi. (B) Today, enjoy a top-notch walking tour of Assisi, the land of St. Francis and St. Clare. The tour includes the Lower and Upper **Basilicas of St. Francis** filled with world famous Giotto frescoes that depict the lives of Jesus and St. Francis, as well as other saints. Pray at the **tombs of St. Francis and his disciples**. Visit other important sights such as St. Francis' birth, his home, and also the **Basilica di Santa Chiara** where the **remains of St. Clare** can be found in its crypt. You will also be able to pray before the famous **Cross of San Damiano** in this Basilica (the Cross that spoke to St. Francis). **Holy Mass*** to be celebrated at one of the basilicas of Assisi. Afterwards, enjoy a leisure afternoon in Assisi with dinner on your own.

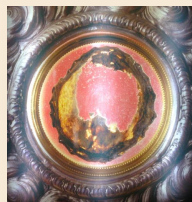


Day 6: Saturday, August 16th: Cascia & Loreto. (B, D)



After breakfast, travel south-east through beautiful landscape until we reach **Cascia**, home to one of Catholicism's most revered saints, **St. Rita**, "The Patron Saint of Impossible Causes" and one of Mater Dei's Patron Saints. During her life, Rita endured much suffering with her husband and sons. After

the loss of her family, Rita receives a second vocation to the Augustinian Sisters. Her entrance into the Order still remains a mystery (or a miracle?). Her love for Jesus was so great that she received the **Stigmata**, but not the way we usually hear about it (where hands and feet and side bear the wounds of Jesus). Her stigmata was related to the pain suffered by Christ with the Crown of Thorns. Rita would suffer the head pains caused by a thorn coming out of the side her forehead. Upon arrival, climb up to the top of the hill using a system of escalators and visit the **Basilica of St. Rita**, housing the **incorruptible body of St. Rita**. After requesting the powerful intercession of this Saint for our own "impossible causes", we may be fortunate enough to receive from one of the sisters, a rose petal that has touched the body of St. Rita. Afterwards, we proceed to the lower chapel where we find the **Eucharistic Miracle of Cascia!** Pray before this Eucharistic Miracle and learn about its amazing story, where we come to realize that we should take extreme care and reverence of the Blessed Sacrament, even in the case of life and death. **Holy Mass*** is requested here. Afterwards, Travel northeast along the Adriatic Sea on the way to an unforgettable visit, a little piece of the Holy Land! The **Marian Shrine of Loreto!** See the beautiful **Madonna of Loreto** and visit the **Holy House of Nazareth**, where Mary received the **Annunciation**. Only 3 walls are present because the fourth wall is actually a grotto in Nazareth. Archeological studies have scientifically matched these two places. A pious tradition tells us that the Holy House was transported to Loreto by Angels in order to protect it from invading infidels. This Shrine has been frequented by many Popes and Saints. We end the day by the Abruzzo Region. Tonight, join your group for dinner.



Day 7: Sunday, August 17th: Lanciano, Manoppello and Rome. (B, D) After breakfast, we travel south to the small picturesque town of **Lanciano**. Lanciano is home to the **oldest Eucharistic Miracle** in Church history. Witness this amazing Miracle where the **Consecrated Host** transformed into human heart tissue (the Heart of Jesus)! After prayer and adoration, **Mass*** is to be celebrated here. Afterwards, continue our travels heading west until we reach **Manoppello**, to visit the **Church of the Volto Santo di Manoppello**, reputed to house **Veronica's Veil!** See up close the Veil's miraculous Image using a system of lights to appreciate the depth, details and even transparency of the Veil. After seeing the church's exhibit about the Manoppello, the Shroud of Turin, the "Sudario" of Oviedo, and the original Divine Mercy Image, continue your travel westward toward the **Capital of Italy** and ancient home of the greatest empire in western civilization, **Roma**. "Welcome to Roma" dinner tonight.



Day 8: Monday, August 18th: Imperial Rome. (B, D) After breakfast, board your motor-coach and travel back in time with a tour of the ancient Capital of the great Roman empire, **Imperial Rome!** Upon arrival in the historical center of Rome, enjoy



a tour inside the famous **Coliseum** (Flavian Amphitheater) built in 72 AD, flanked on one side by the **Arch of Constantine** and surrounded by the impressive **Roman Forum** where the **Arch of Titus** as well as **Julius Caesar's tomb** can be found. Descend and pray at the **Mamertine Prison**, where according to tradition, Peter and Paul lived their last days. **Mass*** to be celebrated at **St. Peter in Chains Church**, where **Michelangelo's Moses** can be found, as well as the **Chains that held Peter** in Rome and Jerusalem. Then enjoy a **panoramic sightseeing tour** from the coach including sites like (subject to new local bus restrictions) the massive **Circus Maximus**, the **Vittorio Emanuel II** monument ("wedding cake building" housing the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier), **Piazza Venezia** (the old Venice Embassy building used by Mussolini to give his famous speeches), the **Capitoline Hill** and more.

Day 9: Tuesday, August 19th: Vatican. (B, L)

Start the day with **Holy Mass*** at **St. Peter's Basilica**. Cross the **Holy Doors of the Jubilee**. After Mass, walk together toward the impressive **Museo Vaticano (Vatican Museum)** for a tour of its fascinating collection of historical artifacts and precious objects of art, including the magnificent **Cappella Sistina (Sistine Chapel)** with the famous **Michelangelo** frescoes featuring the **Last Judgment**. After the museum tour, enjoy a tour of the largest Church in the world, the **Basilica di San Pietro (St. Peter's Basilica)**. There will be a chance to pay respects to **Saint John Paul the Great** at his **tomb** in the **St. Sebastian Altar**, and **Pope Benedict** when we visit the **Crypt of St. Peter**, under the main church, where the **remains of many Popes** can be found, including the **first Pope, St. Peter**. After the tours, enjoy lunch with your group at a nearby restaurant. After lunch, enjoy a leisure afternoon of shopping, strolling and dining on your own. Walk back to our hotel on your own.



Day 10: Wednesday, August 20th: Roma Cristiana 1 + Optional Walk of Old Rome. (B)

Embark on an unforgettable excursion of the treasures of our faith. First, travel south down the '**Via Apia**' (Apian Way) for a powerful journey experiencing how our early brothers and sisters persevered in preserving our Lord's Church. Tour through an amazing complex of underground tunnels, crypts, mausoleum tombs and chapels that fill every passageway in the **Catacombs of St. Callixtus**. One of the highlights of this visit will be the place where the body of St. Cecilia was found. A very realistic statue marks this place portraying the way her body laid, giving a final and resounding testimony to the Blessed Trinity at the time of her death. Next, visit the Basilica of **St. Paul Outside the Walls**, one of the four Patriarchal Basilicas of the Church. Although mostly rebuilt in the 19th century, this Basilica conserves the shape of the original St. Peter's Basilica. In addition to having portraits of every Pope, this Basilica is most famous for housing the remains of **St. Paul**. Afterwards, travel to the location of St. Paul's martyrdom, the **Abbey of Tre Fontane (Three Fountains)**. Here, tradition tells us that St. Paul was decapitated, and a fountain sprung up in each of the 3 locations where his head bounced. Afterwards, enjoy a leisure afternoon on your own or you may want to join us on an informal relaxed walk through the old streets of Rome to stroll by famous and classic places like **Piazza Navona**, the **Pantheon**, the **Trevi Fountain** and the **Spanish Steps**. Dinner on your own tonight.



Day 11: Thursday, August 21st: Christian Rome 2. (B, D) After breakfast, we complete our tour of early Christian Rome. We begin with a visit to **St. Mary Major**, commissioned in the year 360AD (approximately), and known as the first Basilica to be dedicated to the Virgin Mary (Our Lady of the Snows). The famous icon of **Mary, Health of the Roman People**, believed to have been written by St. Luke, can be found in the beautiful **Cappella Paolina** built by Paul V (Farewell Mass* requested here). Then visit '**Santa Croce in Gerusalemme**' (Holy Cross of Jerusalem), where incredible relics can be found (**fragments of the Holy Cross, one Nail, part of the inscription INRI, two thorns from the Crown of Thorns, fragments of the pillar of the scourging and the rock of the Holy Sepulcher**). We owe these beautiful relics, to St. Helena, the mother of Rome's first Christian Emperor, Constantine. This church is built on the site of St. Helen's palace. Afterwards, visit the '**Scala Sancta**' (Holy Stairs) where you may climb the same steps our Lord climbed on the way to see Pontius Pilate. The climb may only be done on your knees. Approximately on every 5 steps, a small circled glass window allows the pilgrim to see the real marble steps below the wooden protective cover. After our lunch break, we end the Cristiana 2 visits with a stop at **San Giovanni Laterano (St. John Lateran)**, the **Cathedral of Rome** (and another one of the Church's four major Basilicas) originally dedicated to Christ Our Savior, and later to St. John the Baptist and to St. John the Evangelist. Adjoining is the Lateran Palace which was the official residence of the Popes before the Avignon captivity. Tonight, join your fellow pilgrims for a festive **Farewell Dinner** reminiscing about the memorable and spiritually impacting events of these past days.



Day 12: Friday, August 22nd: Arrivederci Roma! (B, M) After breakfast, transfer to the airport for our flight to the U.S.A. As our airplane takes off, take one last look at the beautiful land that now holds a special place in our hearts, and say, "**Arrivederci Italia!**" Upon arrival in the USA, clear US Homeland Security. **Welcome Home!**

Purchaser and/or traveler of this tour (you) acknowledges that Landa Cleary Travel Company, Inc. (d.b.a. = doing business as Mater Dei Tours and St. Joseph Tours) is acting as an independent intermediary (travel agent) between you and suppliers of goods and services, which are not directly supplied by Mater Dei Tours, such as air transportation, hotel accommodations, ground and sea transportation, tours, tour guides, escorts, etc. and shall not be responsible for actions or omissions on the part of such suppliers, which may result in any loss, damage, delay or injury to you or your travel companions or group members. Mater Dei Tours and any religious or private organization contracting its services shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages or losses caused to any traveler in connection with social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, war, terrorist activities or any other actions omissions, or conditions outside their control.

By embarking upon his/her travel, the traveler(s) voluntarily assumes all the risks, and is advised to obtain appropriate insurance coverage against them. Your booking shall constitute a consent to the above and engaging the company, acknowledges these conditions and agrees to hold the company blameless in making the arrangements on his/her behalf, and agrees that restitution or damages, if any are claimed, shall be sought directly from the suppliers.

Deposits: A non-refundable deposit of 30% per person is required by December 20, 2024, to secure your Jubilee pilgrimage spot with Mater Dei Tours. Your deposits are used to cover and guarantee your space. Deposits will be refunded in the event the tour does not meet the minimum quorum necessary to make the trip possible. If you use a credit card as payment, you agree that if any cancellation penalties are due, Mater Dei Tours is authorized to charge the penalties to the credit card listed on the registration.

Final Payments: Full payment must be made no later than the date stipulated below. Payments may be made by check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express. If payment is not received as scheduled, your reservation may be automatically canceled and your deposit payment is forfeited. If you use a credit card as payment, for your convenience, you may opt to have Mater Dei Tours charge your balance to the same authorized credit card on the registration form by simply calling us with your verbal authorization.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be received in writing to our company prior to tour departure during normal business hours (9:00am to 5:00pm CST, Monday through Friday). All Cancellations are subject to the following per person penalties prior to departure:

150 days or before.....	30% deposit
140 to 100 days.....	60% of tour
99 to 75 days.....	70% of tour
74 to 50 days.....	80% of tour
49 to 0 days.....	100% of tour (No Refunds)

Mater Dei Tours cannot refund independent purchases of Airfare or Travel Insurance Premiums.

If you use a credit card as payment, you agree that if any cancellation penalties are due, Mater Dei Tours is authorized to charge the penalties to your credit card on record. Traveler agrees to forfeit their reserved space if payment is not made by the designated date. In the case of an approved refund, traveler agrees to forfeit 3% of all credit card charges to cover merchant fees originally absorbed by Mater Dei Tours.

Tour Membership: To ensure a positive experience, Mater Dei Tours reserves the right to reject any client (before or during the trip at the expense of the traveler) whose conduct is incompatible with the interest of the group. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for lost persons and for the expenses incurred while being lost. Each traveler assumes responsibility for staying with the group.

Travelers with Special Needs: Passengers who require attention must advise the tour operator at the time of booking. A qualified and physically able companion must accompany travelers who need such assistance and must assume full responsibility for their well being. Coaches are not equipped with wheelchair accessible ramps, therefore all tour members must be able to mount 3 to 5 steps into the coach. Participants should expect to walk at least 1 to 3 miles minimum in one day. Walking surfaces may at times be uneven. Mater Dei Tours is not responsible for denial of service by any suppliers.

Young Travelers: Travelers who are less than 18 years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult and must share the adult's accommodations. If a child will be traveling with adults other than the parents or with only one parent, it is highly recommended that a notarized letter be written by the parents or non-traveling parent granting authorization to travel, including the dates of travel. We suggest that you also contact the appropriate consulate and airlines because they may have additional requirements.

Roommate Assignments: Mater Dei Tours will make every reasonable attempt to find you a roommate. However, this is not guaranteed. If no roommate is found by the registration deadline, the passenger will have the option to upgrade to a single room (if available) by paying the single occupancy or cancel altogether with a full refund. Mater Dei Tours cannot be held responsible if the roommate you were assigned to is not agreeable to you. If you desire to get your own room, you will be responsible for all the financial consequences of such action, including but not limited to, covering the single occupancy costs of both you and your roommate.

Air Transportation: We have selected airlines that are most suitable with land arrangements. All fares are subject to government approval and are subject to change without notice. Airfares are guaranteed once they have been paid in full and ticketed. Name changes required after tickets have been issued are subject to cancellation and re-ticketing at a higher fare and subject to change fees. Some airlines do not allow you to earn, and/or upgrade with frequent flier miles for group bookings.

Airline Seating: Passengers who require specific seating due to medical conditions are advised to bring Doctor's Orders to the counter so the airlines may have proof of the condition and may accommodate the order. In addition to making the request through our company, please bring the doctor's note to the ticket counter. Passengers who desire a specific non-medical related seat are requested to contact the airline directly, approximately 30 days prior to departure for preferred seating. Group seating is under control of the airline and Mater Dei Tours can only pass on your requests.

Voluntary changes to itinerary: Independent voluntary changes to an individual passenger's itinerary are usually not permitted by most of our tour suppliers. Some exceptions may be granted in a case-by-case basis. All change requests must be made prior to 45 days before departure. If passenger purchased a land only package, they are free to plan their own itinerary before or after the trip (read Land Only bookings for restrictions).

Not Included: All items of a personal nature (room service, beverages, telephone charges, laundry, etc) and meals not specified on the tour itinerary are not included and must be paid by the passenger.

Accommodations and Itinerary: Land arrangements are provided as described in the tour program. The tour company reserves the right to change or substitute (1) hotels for accommodations in similar categories (2) or features of the itinerary in order to accommodate changes in the schedule.

Meals: Meals are provided as specified in the tour program. If you require special meals due to medical dietary restrictions, we must receive written details of your requirements at the time of booking. We cannot guarantee that each and every vendor will honor your requested diet, but every effort will be made to report and accommodate these requests. No weight loss plans or special nutrition diets can be accommodated.

Passports: Obtaining a passport is the sole responsibility of the passenger. Passports must be current and valid beyond the dates of travel (except for Mexico, where your passport needs to be valid just for the dates of travel). **Your airline ticket name must match your passport name or you may be denied boarding the airplane.** Passengers who are denied boarding due to discrepancies between ticket and passport names or because of expired passports accept full responsibility and are subject to the cancellation terms of the tour. Some countries (like Israel) require your passport expiration to be 6 months beyond your travel dates. **We recommend that you apply for your passports (if needed) at the time of registration, but no later than 3 months before departure (using expedited service).**

Tips: Gratuities for baggage, hotel and restaurants detailed in the itinerary are included. **Gratuities for Tour Guide and Motor-coach Driver are NOT included** (unless otherwise stated in the brochure). Please read your "Essential Reading Material" (provided with your travel documents) for recommendations on tipping. (usually \$15 USD per person, per day). Please budget accordingly.

Smoking: Smoking is not allowed on the motor-coach but frequent stops are made throughout the day.

Travel Health: This pilgrimage is being operated under the premise that it is safe to travel under the current health protocols. If governmental authorities and/or our tour vendors, declare that it is no longer safe to travel because of Covid-19 (or any other sickness), Mater Dei will need to cancel the pilgrimage. If all our vendors cancel their services, Mater Dei will issue a full refund to all. If a passenger cancels because of fear of Covid-19 (or any other sickness), but authorities still declare that it is safe to travel as long as people practice the appropriate advice to keep proper hygiene to avoid contamination, the passenger shall be assessed the appropriate cancellation penalty detailed in the first column. Please consider bringing a face mask (may be required by some airlines and/or foreign governments), especially if you are coughing and sneezing. If you are sick with Covid-19 or any other sickness, please stay home.

Total Group Cancellation: If it becomes necessary to cancel an entire tour prior to departure, Mater Dei Tours will offer the next available date or will make a full refund of money paid as soon as all our vendors refund us your money. Mater Dei Tours cannot accept responsibility for any additional costs, fees or cancellation penalties relating to any independent non-refundable purchases (personal airfares, travel insurance, etc.). If you use a credit card as payment, traveler agrees to forfeit 3% of all credit card charges to cover merchant fees absorbed by Mater Dei Tours.

Land Only Bookings: Passenger(s) who desire to book their own airfare do at their own risk. Land only passengers are responsible for connecting with the group at the hotel. Passenger(s) accept all responsibility for costs incurred due to misconnections with the group. Mater Dei Tours cannot accept responsibility for any additional costs or fees related to such a booking or for any cancellation penalties due to independent non-refundable airfare (even if Mater Dei Tours assisted with this booking).
